
Catalyst Network Requirements


- All Catalyst teams must provide their internet requirements so we can work with the venue and ensure the appropriate internet connections are available and demos are properly supported.






Autonomous Network Operations zone












Kiosk equipment

- 2 x 39" monitors with HDMI cables. Screen resolution is 1920 x 1080
- 1 lead retrieval scanner
- 2 x wireless clickers
- 2 x 4 way power bank (NB 2 x monitors use 2 plugs)


- Two wired internet drops estimated at 5-10 MB up/down bandwidth each on a shared backbone

- Private IP Address (special IP addresses available on request here)







- 1 scanner per Catalyst team

Catalyst help-desk



- All Judging will happen on 18th June.
- Each team will be allocated 3 4 Judges.
- Judges visit teams at their stands to interact & score.
- Although recommended, but due to certain time or availability conflicts, Judges MAY or MAY NOT visit the teams together.
- If judges have not visited on 18th / allocated time band, please let us know onsite.
- 90 min time band is allocated to a Judge to visit 3 teams.
- 10 min pitch / demo to judge, to allow time for judges to ask questions. (This is a separate time/activity
- Details of allocated judges & time bands will be available from 10th June onwards – on confluence Member Portal.
- Ensure presence of your key team member at kiosk.
- Judging time band IS DIFFERENT to Arena Stage presentations.


