


#### **INTRODUCTION**

The following document is the specification of the REST API for ServiceQualification management. It includes the model definition as well as all available operations.

In the Open Digital Economy where multiple actors (SDPs, CSPs, ...) may be involved with the delivery of an end-to-end service, those actors need to collaborate and interact with the customer as needed.

Following diagram shows ServiceQualification API within pre-ordering API package:



Service Qualification API is one of Pre-Ordering Management API Family. Service Qualification API goal is to provide service technical eligibility in the context of the interaction. This API allows to:

- request a specific service eligibility,
- look for service eligibles (or not) from a service category,
- look for service eligibles (or not) from a service specification and characteristics.

Because the API allows describing service from the inventory, it is also possible to use it to retrieve service available to complete existing service.

In the request, the following attributes could/must be filled:

- service, serviceSpecification, category or service characteristics will be indicated (at least one is mandatory),
- relatedParty, for which the qualification must be done,
- place, where the customer wants his service,
- · expected qualification date.

In the response, the API will provide qualification result but also:

- Eligibility unavailability reason (if any)
- Alternate service proposal (if any)



# **SAMPLE USE CASES**

Reader will find example of use cases using Usage API in "Open Digital Business Scenarios and Use Cases" document.

To provide some use-cases:

- Retrieve maximum download/upload speed for an access service at a specified address
- Check if we can deliver new access and IPTV (4k) services at a specified address
- Check if we can deliver new IP TV service at the same location of an existing and active Accesse service (i.e. without explicitly specifying address)
- Check if we can upgrade the download speed of an existing and active service from 100 Mb/s to 600Mb/s
- ...




# **RESOURCE MODEL**

#### Managed Entity and Task Resource Models

#### SERVICE QUALIFICATION RESOURCE

ServiceQualification is used to perform a technical eligibility. It allows to retrieve a list of services that are technically available in the context of the interaction (place, party, service characteristics,...).


#### Resource model

#### **ServiceQualification**

estimatedResponseDate	A sate (DateTime). Date when the requester expect to provide an answer for the qualification request.
effectiveQualificationDate	A date (DateTime). Effective date to serviceQualification completion.
expirationDate	A date (DateTime). Date when the qualification response expires.
provideAlternative	A boolean. An indicator which when the value is "true" means that alternative solutions should be provided.
provideOnlyAvailable	A boolean. An indicator which when the value is "true" means that only available service must be listed in the response.
provideUnavailabilityReason	A boolean. An indicator which when the value is "true" means that unavailability reason are expected for non available service.
@baseType	A string. Indicates the base type of the resource. Here can be serviceQualification.
@type	A string. Indicates the type of resource. Here can be serviceQualification.
@schemaLocation	A string. Link to schema describing this REST resource.
serviceQualificationItem	A list of service qualification items. ServiceQualificationItem [*]).
relatedParty	A list of related party references (RelatedPartyRef [*]). A related party defines party or party role linked to a specific entity.

#### AlternateServiceProposal sub-resource

Alternate service proposal is used when the requested service is not available with characteristics and date asked for. An alternate proposal could be a distinct service close to the requested one or same as the requested but with a different availability date.

#### Place sub-resource

Service reference. Configure the service characteristics & relationships (only configurable characteristics and necessary only if a non-default value is selected) and/or identify the service that needs to be modified/deleted.

#### **Notification Resource Models**

3 notifications are defined for this API




Notifications related to ServiceQualification:

- ServiceQualificationCreationNotification
- ServiceQualificationStateChangeNotification
- ServiceQualificationRemoveNotification

The notification structure for all notifications in this API follow the pattern depicted by the figure below. A notification resource (depicted by "SpecificNotification" placeholder) is a sub class of a generic Notification structure containing an id of the event occurrence (eventId), an event timestamp (eventTime), and the name of the notification resource (eventType).

This notification structure owns an event structure ("SpecificEvent" placeholder) linked to the resource concerned by the notification using the resource name as access field ("resourceName" placeholder).

# **API OPERATIONS**

Remember the following Uniform Contract:

Operation on Entities	Uniform API Operation	Description
Query Entities	GET Resource	GET must be used to retrieve a representation of a resource.
Create Entity	POST Resource	POST must be used to create a new resource
Partial Update of an Entity	PATCH Resource	PATCH must be used to partially update a resource
Complete Update of an Entity	PUT Resource	PUT must be used to completely update a resource identified by its resource URI
Remove an Entity	DELETE Resource	DELETE must be used to remove a resource
Execute an Action on an Entity	POST on TASK Resource	POST must be used to execute Task Resources
Other Request Methods	POST on TASK Resource	GET and POST must not be used to tunnel other request methods.

Filtering and attribute selection rules are described in the TMF REST Design Guidelines.

#### POST /serviceQualification

#### **Description**

This operation creates a service qualification entity.

#### **Mandatory and Non Mandatory Attributes**

The following tables provides the list of mandatory and non mandatory attributes when creating a ServiceQualification, including any possible rule conditions and applicable default values. Notice that it is up to an implementer to add additional mandatory attributes.

# PATCH /serviceQualification/{id}

#### **Description**

This operation allows partial updates of a service qualification entity. Support of json/merge (https://tools.ietf.org/html/rfc7386) is mandatory, support of json/patch (http://tools.ietf.org/html/rfc5789) is optional.

Note: If the update operation yields to the creation of sub-resources or relationships, the same rules concerning mandatory sub-resource attributes and default value settings in the POST operation applies to the PATCH operation. Hence these tables are not repeated here.

# **API NOTIFICATIONS**

For every single of operation on the entities use the following templates and provide sample REST notification POST calls.

It is assumed that the Pub/Sub uses the Register and UnRegister mechanisms described in the REST Guidelines reproduced below.

#### REGISTER LISTENER

#### POST /hub

#### **Description**

Sets the communication endpoint address the service instance must use to deliver information about its health state, execution state, failures and metrics. Subsequent POST calls will be rejected by the service if it does not support multiple listeners. In this case DELETE /api/hub/{id} must be called before an endpoint can be created again.

#### **Behavior**

Returns HTTP/1.1 status code 204 if the request was successful.

Returns HTTP/1.1 status code 409 if request is not successful.

#### **Usage Samples**

Here's an example of a request for registering a listener.

#### PUBLISH EVENT TO LISTENER

#### POST /client/listener

#### **Description**

Clears the communication endpoint address that was set by creating the Hub.

Provides to a registered listener the description of the event that was raised. The /client/listener url is the callback url passed when registering the listener.

#### **Behavior**

Returns HTTP/1.1 status code 201 if the service is able to set the configuration.

#### **Usage Samples**

Here's an example of a notification received by the listener. In this example "EVENT TYPE" should be replaced by one of the notification types supported by this API (see Notification resources Models section) and EVENT BODY refers to the data structure of the given notification type.
