GETTING STARTED

- 1. REGISTER FOR BLUEMIX**
If you don't already have a Bluemix account, go to Bluemix and [register](#)
- 2. CREATE AN APP**
Navigate to the [Catalog](#) and select your preferred language from the available Runtimes. Give the app a unique host to serve as it's URL. Deploy. Just want a service? Skip this step and just create the service from the [catalog](#).
- 3. ADD A SERVICE**
Select ADD A SERVICE to add one of the services from the Catalog. When the app asks for a RESTAGE, accept the restage. Select the service's tile and then Service Credentials to view API connection information.
