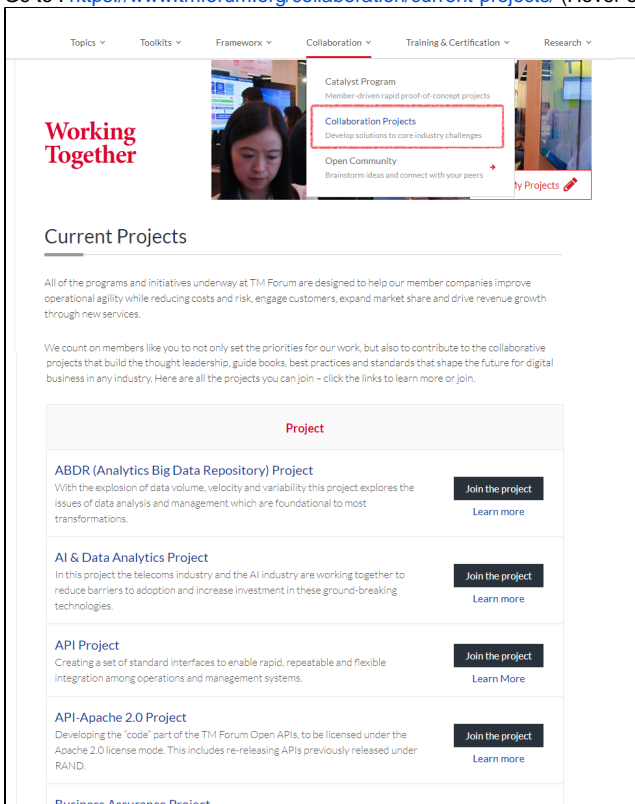


Joining a Project

To join a TM Forum Development Project follow these simple steps:

1. Navigate to www.tmforum.org and log in to your account (or register for an account if you haven't registered as a user on our website).
2. Go to : <https://www.tmforum.org/collaboration/current-projects/> (Hover over the 'Collaboration' menu option and select 'Collaboration Projects')

5. If you are not logged in to your www.tmforum.org account you will be prompted to do so - or invited to register if you don't already have an account

6. You will then be shown the project joining screen with the IPR declaration. Select those projects you would like to engage with.

Application for Applications Project Area

IPR Mode: RAND

To join a project you need to agree to the conditions surrounding the handling of Intellectual Property, IPR, that might be used by you or the other members of the project. Like most industry collaborative organisations we use RAND, meaning "on fair, reasonable, and non-discriminatory terms which may include a reasonable royalty". This is the legal framework within which we operate to protect the interests of all parties. When you agree to the RAND terms by ticking the box below, your agreement will be emailed to the IP Contact within your organisation who will authorize your access to the project. Until your IP Contact sends authorization, you will not be able to see the working documents produced by the project. You will receive an email confirming/denying access to the project and a link to it if you have been authorized.

7. Depending on your company's preference, either your request to join the project is approved automatically or a request is then routed to your company's IPR contact who will need to give you permission to join the project. In this case, you will receive a copy of this request for your records. Your company's IPR contact has 14 days to process your request, so it can take that long to approve. Please make a note of your company's IPR contact so you can contact them if you need to.
8. Once your IPR contact has approved your access request you will receive an email informing you that you now have access and provide a link to access the work space for your project
